



Doctor of Pharmacy Program – New Student To Do List

Below is a “to-do” list with items to be completed once accepted to the PharmD program. **Please read carefully and complete the tasks appropriately.**

- ☐ Review letter from the Financial Planning Coordinator and file Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at <https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/fafsa> immediately.
- ☐ Review technology requirements and purchase an electronic device that is in compliance with these requirements.
- ☐ Required Immunizations (Please start gathering these documents for submission in Spring of 2022)
 - ☐ **MMR:** Two doses of measles-containing vaccine Measles-Mumps-Rubella (German Measles) **OR** a positive antibody titer.
 - ☐ **HEPATITIS A:** Two doses of vaccine **OR** a positive antibody titer.
 - ☐ **HEPATITIS B:** Three doses of vaccine **AND** a positive Hepatitis B surface antibody titer (HBsAg).
 - ☐ **VARICELLA:** Two doses of varicella-containing vaccine given after 12 months of age and at least one month apart **OR** a positive antibody titer. (Will not accept proof of disease history)
 - ☐ **COVID-19:** Two doses of vaccine
 - ☐ **TETANUS-DIPHTHERIA-PERTUSSIS:** One dose of Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis) administered after 11 years of age **AND** if Tdap is beyond 10 years, a Tdap or Td booster within the last 10 years.

What “counts” as official documentation for student health compliance?

Documentation must clearly indicate your name, at least two patient identifiers, clear indication of vaccine administered, or test performed, and date. Acceptable documentation of immunizations and titers include, but are not limited to:

- Official copies from a state immunization registry
- Copies of immunization, lab reports and/or health records from a provider’s office, another educational institution, an authorized public health representative, or military service.
- Pharmacy leaflet indicating immunization administration
- Titers must include either: 1) lab value and reference range for interpretation; or 2) qualitative interpretation.

Please note - Instructions for submitting immunization records as well as requirements for **tuberculosis screening** and the **physical exam** will be released in the Spring of 2022.
