Once that is completed along with the additional student information forms that I will send to you via email, I will email you an Estimated Financial Plan (Award Letter) showing you the maximum amounts of Federal Loans you qualify for. We will then schedule a meeting to discuss the fine points of your Award Letter either in person or online.
